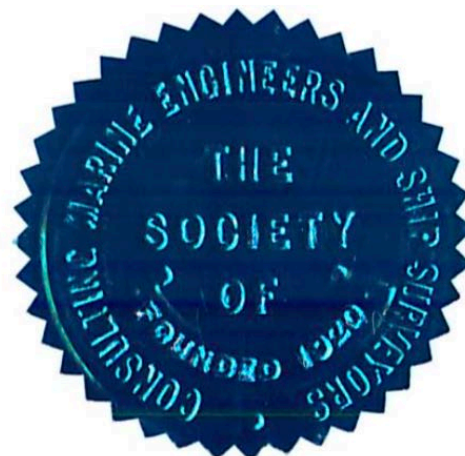

Conditions and Limitations

- That the vessel fully complies with the owner/managing agent's signed declaration;
- That the vessel complies with the Document of Compliance SWB2;
- That if the vessel requires stability information, such information is carried on board the vessel;
- That when the vessel is sold this certificate is automatically cancelled and should be returned to the SCMS office;
- Vessel may operate continuously at sea for periods of more than 24 hours in accordance with relevant points in section 21 of the Code of Practice with a maximum of 5 (FIVE) persons providing the operation of the vessel is fully compliant with Hours of Work and Rest Regulations.
- Vessel operations and loading must always be in full compliance with the Approved Stability Book;
- Vessel to operate in BV Sea Area 3 (where maximum significant wave height will not exceed 4.0 metres over 10% of the year)
